



FRAUD STOPPER FORM

“HAVE YOU EARNED YOUR SENIOR SHIELD?”

Attention senior citizens! An unfortunate trend in today’s society is scam artists posing as contractors. These fraudulent contractors typically offer unsolicited services in order to con money out of unsuspecting seniors. **Be aware and protect yourself!**

Tips to avoid being a victim of fraud:

1. **Three important general rules:**

- If a person approaches with an offer for unsolicited work, kindly refuse.
- Never pay in advance for services.
- Never let a stranger into your home.

2. Ask **“Have you earned your Senior Shield?”** and request to see their Senior Shield ID card. If provided, check against government issued photo ID and verify by calling 1-866-650-7226. If verified, contractor has been independently approved and is an authenticated member of the Senior Shield Network.

3. If they are unable to prove Senior Shield status, insist that the contractor complete the following **Contractor Verification Form** and return it to you before discussing any services. If contractor returns form, contact your local contractor licensing board and listed references before initiating work.
